## Distractions

On June 20th our Christian Chapel Youth Group along with Chase and myself traveled to Maywood Christian Camp for the week. Leaving home is always bitter-sweet though the call of Maywood is powerful. It is spiritually intoxicating to withdraw from the busyness of life away from basically all that is electronic that seems to consume so much of our time. There we live life without the *distractions* (this year's theme) that draw us away from spiritual creativity. We studied God's Word, praised our Creator in song, spent nights in devotional, and fed from one another's progress. I cannot begin to describe the emotion of standing under the stars during a ball field devotional, witnessing the spiritual growth of self and others, hearing voices and hearts of young people blend in harmony making melody to the Lord, or listening to the quiet, heart-wrenching prayer of an innocent child at bed time. Maywood changes people; it changed me over 20 years ago and continues to have a profound impact on my life at the young old age of 41. Tony Brown often reminds counselors that we can provide love to a child that may not know love at home. It has been my theory in the past that we are there to teach the children and though we do, I believe now more than ever that the children are actually teaching the adults. They cry out for attention as we freely give ourselves to not only teaching them how to become a child of God, but equally important, how to live as a child of God. They remind us of the depth of commitment along with the dedication of our life to the Lord's cause. As a result, we dig deeper into our own soul to purge out the weeds that hinder our Christianity so that we can be re-created in the Lord. I went to Maywood in a semi-distracted state, sometimes coasting through my faith. The kids that I went to share my faith with demonstrated to me why I am alive--truly alive: I am purposed to serve God as all men are created to do. Are you distracted today? Are there things in your life that hinder you from spiritual progress and maturity? There is only one way out and one way up--it is to surrender completely to God. Please do not let a worldly life distract you from what God has intended for you. Remember the innocence of a child, the power of example, and the glory that we can bring to God by allowing our lights to shine in a gloomy world. God is able to do exceedingly, abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us (Eph 3.20). May God change us from the inside so that we can help change others from the outside!
