GIVING OURSELVES IN 2012 GALATIANS 5:13-14

A SERVANT AND HIS MASTER (MATTHEW 10)

In this chapter, Jesus called his disciples to him for the purpose of assigning a commission to the ones that we recognize as the 12 Apostles. He instructed them to preach to their countrymen a simple message: "The kingdom of heaven is at hand." They were not to take extra possessions with them for self-reliance, but were to depend solely upon God for their well-being. Because Jesus warned he was sending them out as "sheep in the midst of wolves", they were advised to be "wise as serpents and innocent as doves" (16). He further warned that their enemies would be from their own families while others would hate them because of Jesus and what he stood for. The most important aspect of this commission in my opinion are the words: "But the one who endures to the end will be saved" (22b).

The reason this is paramount is found in the next few verses. "A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a servant above his master. It is enough for the disciple to be like his teacher, and the servant like his master" (24-25). In their commission to acknowledge Christ as Savior before men (32), Jesus *assured* them that they would receive persecution—just like him. When they performed the work that Jesus prepared for them in proclaiming the gospel from the housetops (27), they would suffer at the hands of those opposed to the Messiah. Maybe these were not willing to give up their religion, go against their family members, or simply were not ready to cede their traditions. However, Jesus plainly stated that the gospel would not bring peace, but a sword (34). Jesus modeled servant-hood, he embodied perseverance and determination—he endured to the end. Are we committed to Him?

How can we know if we are living the life of a servant to the Master? If we are sharing the good news of salvation about Jesus, we will be mistreated, we will be persecuted just as he was. Hopefully, this does not entail being crucified to a cross but it does demand that we be crucified to the evils of the world. There is nothing here worth holding on to because this life will not last forever. We must learn to lose our life in Christ in order for our soul to be saved in eternity. It is ironic that we must let go our attachment to everything *temporary* in order to gain access to what is *permanent*. This is the life of a Christian. Is Jesus your teacher? Master? Are you ready and willing to serve? Together, let us take up our own cross and follow him (38). The one who endures to the end *will be saved!* ~With love, MJR
