### Can I Be a Disciple of Christ? Luke 14.25-33

Jesus cautioned his followers that there is a cost involved when contemplating discipleship. His instruction is challenging and bears attention: “If anyone comes to me and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple” (Lk 14.26). Wow! The expense of discipleship requires positioning Christ before anyone else—even our family! How can we balance this prescription to *hate* anyone who separates us from Christ? With this sharp requirement we realize the magnitude of how vital our decision becomes when we choose to serve Jesus. It may isolate us from our family as a result. The direction to *hate* family members only becomes possible if we allow them to cause us to reject Him. Families do not offer salvation—Jesus does. Families do not die for sinners—Jesus did. No one must be allowed to divert one’s allegiance to the Lord. We are further advised: “Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple” (14.27). Anyone who chooses willingly to follow Jesus will have to make difficult decisions, even to the point of forfeiting relationships that might threaten to derail one’s salvation. Serving Jesus is the ultimate call and demands ultimate commitment. The cross that a person must bear is not only initial obedience, but also daily decisions necessary to maintain discipleship. This is the ideal that Jesus demonstrated to perfection. Our resolution must be that we will follow Jesus—no matter the consequences when others, even our family members, would undermine our faith.

Jesus concluded: “So therefore, any one of you who does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple” (14.33). ). Three times herein Jesus informed that if one is not ready to sacrifice everything in this world that person cannot be His disciple. This requires solemn deliberation. What am I willing to give up? What am I willing to sacrifice? Will I allow relationships to dictate my belief? If necessary, can I oppose my family, another religion, traditions, or the philosophy of men? Any of these things will threaten discipleship because they can distract us from eternal focus. The choice is simple: OBEY AND FOLLOW CHRIST. It is people, including ourselves, who complicate the issue by proposing other alternatives for happiness or even salvation. In effect, Jesus encourages and warns us to choose Him by remembering that there is nothing in this world more important than exalting Him. Assuredly, when we focus on Him, we will love and respect others with a greater and deeper passion—just as our Savior did when He surrendered His life to the Father. Are you willing to be His disciple? *Can you be His disciple?* He offered His sacrifice for you and me to be able to make this decision. ~With love, MJR
